

Guidelines regarding the Practical Courses (MJML020 and MJML021) of MAJMC and PGJMC

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- SOJNMS has launched a Masters Program in Journalism and Mass Communication in January 2020. As earlier communicated, all the existing study centres of PGJMC are by default activated for MAJMC.
- In the first year of MAJMC (as well as in PGJMC), there are six theory courses and two practical courses. As per the University norms, learners are required to submit their theory assignments to their respective study centres. For the practical courses, students are required to submit their practical portfolios (for MJML020 & MJML021) to their respective study centres.
- A Practical manual for these two practical courses is uploaded on the eGyankosh website for information and reference to the students, RCs and LSCs.
- After completing the activities mentioned in the practical manual, students are advised to submit the hard copy of their portfolios, along with the CD/DVD containing various exercises, to their respective study centres.
- Any approved academic counsellors may evaluate these portfolios and will take the viva-voce exam for these two practical courses through offline or online mode. Academic counsellors may handover evaluated marks to their respective RCs for further necessary action.
- As per the evaluation pattern, portfolio carries 70% of weightage and viva voce exam carries 30% of weightage. The evaluation criteria are explained in detail in the attached practical manuals for MAJMC and PGJMC.
- As conveyed by the Program Coordination, the existing payment norms towards project evaluation are applicable to the evaluation of MJML020 and MJML021.
