

POST GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN MEDICAL MANAGEMENT OF CBRNE DISASTERS (PGCMDM)

IGNOU is offering a six months Certificate in Medical Management of Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosive (CBRNE) Disasters (PGCMDM) Programme, developed in collaboration with INMAS, DRDO for MBBS graduates and inservice doctors with Indian citizenship. The programme creates awareness and builds competencies for medical management of CBRNE casualties. Besides classes by experts from DRDE and INMAS, DRDO, hands on training at AIIMS in Bhopal, Rishikesh, Jodhpur and NIMS Hyderabad is carried out.

Learners will be able to learn-

- ▶ what happens during a nuclear bomb explosion, dirty bomb dispersion, nuclear power station disasters like Chernobyl & Fukushima, Pandemic etc.
- ▶ how the CBRNE agents harm human body and society
- ▶ how to decontaminate, protect and mitigate using medical technologies
- ▶ what are the common chemical warfare agents and toxic industrial chemicals that have or can cause disaster
- ▶ how are the CBRNE agents detected and controlled
- ▶ how are the harmful effects of these agents on the body diagnosed and treated
- ▶ pre-hospital and hospital management technologies

Eligibility: Medical doctors with MBBS degree recognized by MCI and having Indian Citizenship

Duration: Minimum: 6 months Maximum: 2 years
