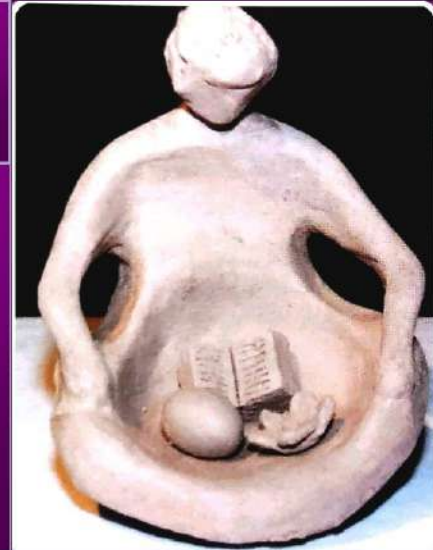


Master of Arts in Women's and Gender Studies (MAWGS)

The Master's degree programme in Women's & Gender Studies is on offer in open and distance education mode from July 2013. The first year curriculum consists of four core foundations courses in Women's & Gender Studies. Second year specializations provide a deeper understanding of issues within the framework of either 'Women's Studies' or Gender, Literature & Culture'. The programme has been launched in modular form with an exit point at the PG Diploma level after successful completion of coursework prescribed for first two semesters.
