We wish to inform you that your name appears in the **First List (Provisional)** for admission to B.Ed. 2020. You must attend the counseling at the specified Time if you are interested for admission.

Please submit Acceptance Form, course option proforma, identity card (you have to paste a recent passport sized photograph on identity card proforma) & checklist of documents duly filled-in and signed along with attested copies of the documents as mentioned at S. No. 3. If your admission is not confirmed due to non-availability of seat under your category, then your DD will be returned back.

The Admission Counselling Date and Time are mentioned on the Address Label pasted on this letter. Counselling schedule for B.Ed Admissions is also available at RC Nagpur Website.

- 1. If you are offered seat under "Reserved Category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL)", it is mentioned on the address label pasted on this letter. It is your responsibility to enclose all certificates including "Caste Validity Certificate" and prove that you are eligible for admission under this category. If relevant certificates are not submitted, your admission is liable for rejection.
- 2. You have to submit your application along with following documents (true copies of attested/self attested relevant documents, to be verified against original):

**Documents to be submitted by Applicant** (Carry all the Originals documents for verification and one set photocopies duly self attested)

#### A) By All Applicants:

- 1) High School/Secondary/Senior Secondary Mark Sheet and Certificates.
- 2) Graduation or Post graduation Mark Sheet and Certificates. Please note that you have to produce photocopies of mark-sheet for each year of graduation.
- 3) Mark Sheet and Certificate of NCTE Recognized Teacher Education Programme (eg. D.ED) completed through Face to Face mode.
- 4) A Certificate issued by the Institution, where the candidate has pursued his/her teacher education programme through face to face mode, stating that the Institution is recognized for offering the teacher education programme through face to face mode by NCTE, along with a copy of the recognition letter issued by NCTE to that institution. In case the recognition letter is not available, then a certificate issued by the Institution should contain the details of the letter number and date of issue of recognition/approval for offering the teacher education programme through face to face mode by the NCTE.
- 5) Original Certificate from the recognized Upper Primary/Secondary/Senior Secondary Schools to provide facilities for Practical Work including Internship, as per the format enclosed as (Enclosure 1)
- 6) Submit subject selection format and declaration (Enclosure 2)
- 7) Experience Certificate(s), if experience is claimed.
- 8) Original BED Entrance Examination Admit Card.
- 9) Original Anti-ragging Affidavits in the prescribed formats duly Notorised and signed by Parents and Applicant separately, as enclosed as (Enclosure 3 & 4).
- **10)** Crossed Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank for **Rs.50,000/-** (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) towards the programme fee should be in favour of **IGNOU**, **payable at NAGPUR.** Write your Name, Enrolment Number and Programme on the reverse of the Demand Draft.
- 11) One Passport size Photograph

## B) By Applicants claiming reserved seat:

- **12)** Category (SC/ST) Certificate for claiming SC/ST Seat with validity certificate wherever applicable
- 13) OBC-Non creamy Layer Certificate along with Income Certificate for claiming OBC (Noncreamy Layer) Seat. The Certificate, not older than 3 years, should be in the format as given in the Student Handbook and Prospectus of the B.Ed Programme. The annual income of the candidate under OBC (Non Creamy layer) should not exceed 8 lakhs per annum and only the central list will be followed. No change of category code shall be entertained from the candidates after the submission of Entrance cum Admission form
- 14) Latest Income Certificate issued by Govt. competent authorities (Applicable for OBC non creamy candidates only)

- 15) Economically weaker section (EWS) certificate issued by the government. (Applicable for EWS candidates only)
- **16)** Certificate of Physically Handicapped for claiming PH Category seat, with a minimum of 40% disability.
- 17) War-widow Certificate for claiming War Widow Seat, Female candidates under the category of War-widow who furnish necessary certificate from the recognized Defence Authority in support of their claim to avail the reservation under this category are entitled for reservation
- 18) Kashmiri Migrant Certificate for claiming KM Seat

### B) By the Applicants whose name is changed after High School (all documents listed below):

In case any change in the name (other than the one mentioned in his/her High School Certificate), then it is mandatory for the prospective learners to furnish legal evidence of having changed his/her name/surname while submitting the admission form, as given below:

- 19) Affidavit sworn in before 1st Class Magistrate specifying the change in the name.
- 20) A copy of News paper, where notification for change of name was published
- 21) Copy of the Gazette Notification (not required for female candidates after marriage)
- **22)** In case of changed Surname after marriage, Marriage Certificate issued by Registrar (Marriages) or Marriage Card.

## 3. You are advised to note the following:

"This offer of admission is provisional and is based on the documents in respect of qualification and other eligible criteria submitted by you along with the application form. If at a later stage, it is found that the document(s) submitted by you is/are false, your admission shall stand cancelled forthwith and no fee refund will be admissible in the event of such cancellation of admission."

- I. The Confirmation of the admission will be informed to you by email at later date once all the admission activates are completed.
- II. No interim queries will be entertained, please.
- III. It's compulsory to attend the admission counselling on the specified date and time. In Absentia of the candidate, the seat will be offered to the next person in the merit order and no queries will be entertained in this regard.
- IV. A register of attendance of all applicants coming for the counseling will be maintained where your signature and time of arrival for the counseling will be recorded. The time of arrival is important for the allotment of the seat.
- V. In case, you are **unable to take admission**, for any reason whatsoever, please inform at the scheduled date/time so that the candidate ranking next in order of *Merit* can be granted admission. If you are not available at the scheduled date and time, you will be having no right for admission at later stage.
- VI. Medium & Course once opted will not be changed, at the later date.
- VII. Please check all the documents to be attached with checklist of documents and arrange the documents as per order given in checklist.
- VIII. Please note that you have to produce all your Original Mark sheets, Degree Certificates, appointment letters & experience certificate in support of educational qualifications/experience claimed before admission committee during counselling on scheduled date for Verification.
